Restricted & Prohibited Waste is NOT to be Landfilled

Materials and Disposal Requirements

Refuse Material	Management / Disposal
Cardboard	Self-haul to Do-Your-Part Recycling or arrange bin and pick-up service with Geier Waste Services or Waste Management.
Paper	Designate a clear plastic bag on site for paper and take to Do-Your-Part Recycling. It may be possible to arrange for pick-up service from Do-Your-Part for a fee.
Metal	Loads of metal waste less than 5m ³ may be taken to Thornhill Transfer Station (Tipping fees apply). Alternatively, metal waste may be self-hauled to local salvage companies. It may also be possible to arrange bin delivery and pick-up with these companies.
Broken Concrete >30cm	Arrange for hauling to Forceman Ridge Waste Management Facility. Broken concrete disposal requires approval of a Controlled Waste Permit.
Broken Asphalt >30cm	Arrange for hauling to Forceman Ridge Waste Management Facility. Broken asphalt disposal requires approval of a Controlled Waste Permit.
Organics	This includes all food scraps, food soiled paper (i.e. napkins, pizza boxes), and yard waste such as leaves and grass clippings. Bin delivery and pick-up service may be arranged through Geier Waste Services or Waste Management. Alternatively, organics may be self-hauled to the Thornhill Transfer Station (Tipping fees apply).
Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) materials	This includes all products covered under a Provincial Product Stewardship Program, such as; batteries, electronics, light bulbs, tires, paint & solvents, and used oil & filters. These products must be taken to the appropriate depot. A list of EPR depots in the Terrace area is provided on the insert of this brochure.

Additional Prohibited Waste Materials

- Hazardous or Radioactive Waste
- Slaughter Waste
- Waste that is on fire, smoldering, capable of starting fires, or flammable materials
- Explosive or highly combustible materials
- Sewage Waste
- Auto Hulks

Controlled Waste

Any material containing asbestos is considered "Controlled Waste". Asbestos disposal requires approval of a Controlled Waste Permit through the Regional District (Administration fees apply). All controlled waste loads are directed to Forceman Ridge Waste Management Facility. The hauler must have an account with the Regional District to tip at Forceman Ridge. All Controlled Waste Applications must be submitted to the Regional District a minimum of 48 hours prior to disposal for review.

Other materials considered "Controlled Waste" include; contaminated soils, clean soils, and any load of land clearing or construction and demolition waste greater than 5m³ in volume. These materials also require approval of a Controlled Waste Permit for hauling to Forceman Ridge.

Clean wood waste (not including painted, pressure treated, plywood or laminate wood) should also be kept separate from general garbage. There is a designated "clean wood" bin at the Thornhill Transfer Station.
