

THE Top 10

Items most commonly found in your curbside recycling pick-up that **do not** belong in your bag.

The following items are **NOT accepted** in the Greater Terrace Area Curbside Recycling Program. They are considered contamination and if found in your recycling bag, will not be picked up.

1. **Plastic bags** (shopping bags), **Ziploc bags, or Ziploc style bags** (any plastic bag or pouch with a zip seal)
2. **All other film plastics/overwrap** (For example: Plastic seals from items like yogurt, plastics covering toilet paper or paper towel)
3. **Glass (Bottles and Jars)**
4. **Plastic Foam Packaging—white and coloured** (For example: Foam containers and trays used for meat and product, foam egg cartons, foam cups and bowls for take-out food, plastic foam cushion packaging to protect electronics/small appliances)
5. **Non-paper gift wrap** (For example: foil gift wrap, bows and ribbons)
6. **Beverage containers** (all cans, juice boxes, aseptic “drink boxes” or gable top cartons, and liquor bottles covered under Encorp Beverage— <http://www.return-it.ca/beverage/>)
7. **Motor oil, motor oil containers, or filters**
8. **Organics** (food scraps, and yard waste)
9. **Granola bar/protein bar/chocolate bar wrappers, or chip bags**
10. **Containers that are not rinsed out and have materials such as food or chemicals left in them**
