

Media Release #6 June 3, 2021 5:30 p.m.

Recent heavy rain on a melting snowpack has increased flows considerably overnight, especially in the Skeena River watershed. The Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine has declared a Local State of Emergency for Area C to include parts of Old Remo and New Remo. An Evacuation Order has also been issued for these areas (see Media Release #4).

An Evacuation Alert (see Media Release #5) has been issued for Dutch Valley. This area is well known for flooding associated with high spring freshet.

Should any RDKS and City of Terrace residents require sandbags, these are available at the Thornhill Volunteer Fire Department 3128 Hwy 16 East.

Specific instructions as follows:

Those individuals who have may be evacuated or have been forced out due to flooding need to report to the Thornhill Community Centre at 3091 Century Street in Thornhill for registration and assistance. They can also be reached at 250-641-2443

At this time residents and businesses in low-lying areas and areas which have experienced flooding in the past should take steps to flood proof their structures, including moving valuable items to higher ground, finding alternate locations for livestock, and finding alternate accommodations should the need for evacuation occur.
