

Wildfire Information Update

The Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine has rescinded (cancelled) the evacuation alert for **Wildfire #R41510 Woodcock, 1 mile North of Woodcock Airport between 8 km & 23 km on the Cedervale Road**. The alert was rescinded at the recommendation of BC Wildfire as the wildfire no longer poses a threat to residents or property in the area.

EVACUATION ALERT RESCINDED (CANCELLED)

Woodcock Wildfire # R41510

Date: July 24, 2023 and Time: 16:00 (4:00pm)

The **Evacuation Alert**, pursuant to the Emergency Program Act, issued by the Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine (RDKS) on July 14, 2023 at 17:00 has been rescinded (cancelled) effective July 24, 2023 based on the recommendation from BC Wildfire, as the wildfire in the area no longer poses threat to life and property of residents present in Woodcock, 1 mile North of Woodcock Airport between 8 km & 23 km on the Cedarvale Road. (as shown on the attached map).

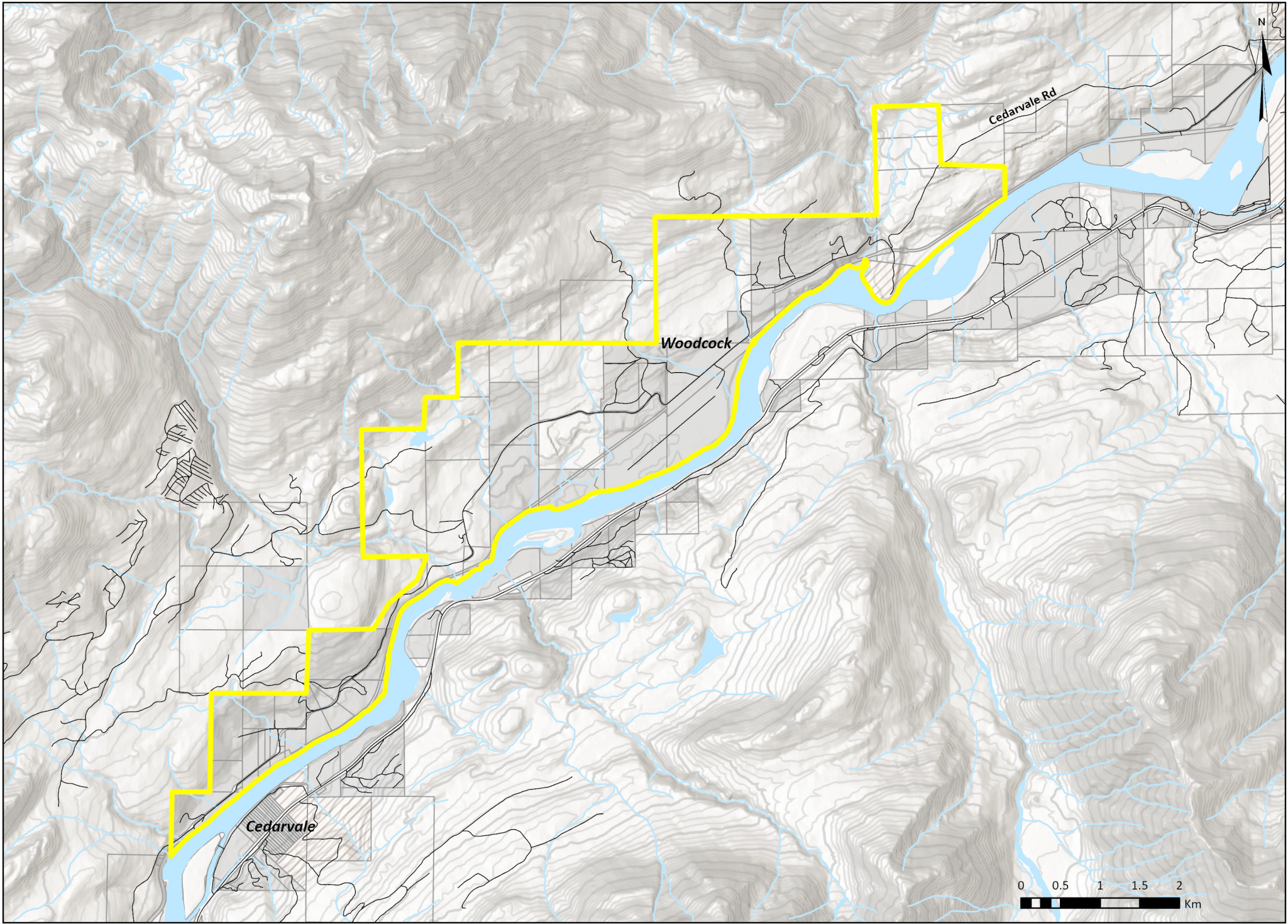
An Evacuation Alert may need to be reissued if conditions degrade; however, if that is deemed necessary, a notification of the Evacuation Alert or Order process will re-commence.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO in the event conditions change:

- It is recommended that everyone register with the RDKS Mass notification system for real time updates. <https://vovent-alert.com/ca/community/>
- Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government-issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information), immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all your household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles. If transportation assistance is needed, call ESS at 250-641-2443.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating. Monitor the RDKS website at www.rdks.bc.ca and social media pages/news/radio for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres.
